



Compost Market Structure In Scotland August 2001

Availability and Price Structure

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1. Introduction

On behalf of the *REMADE* programme, a detailed telephone and fax survey of the market developments for composted products was undertaken during June-August 2001. The objectives were to:

- Identify companies and organisations marketing compost in Scotland
- Assess the range and style of composted products
- Determine the price structure of the market, particularly in comparison to competitive peat-based products
- To provide feedback for compost manufacturers to assist market development

Individual companies were approached initially by telephone and subsequently by fax/letter, outlining the scope of the *REMADE* programme. Respondents were asked to supply information on product ranges and pricing structure. Company-specific information remains confidential, but is used in this report to assess the trends and price developments for the sector. All product prices are ex-works and therefore take no account of the cost of transportation, which can be very significant. In using this data to develop operational costings, for instance, for the use of compost on construction sites, the proximity of the site to the compost producer should always be taken into account as this can be a decisive factor. Nonetheless, the data provides a useful insight into the current market position and price structure for composted materials in Scotland. The survey includes compost suppliers in England where they were prepared to quote for delivery to a Scottish customer. Not all suppliers are compost manufacturers but all those contacted for this survey are commercial traders not supplying the general public.

A total of 51 (fifty one) companies responded to the survey. Companies offer products in bags, ranging from 5 litres to in excess of 150 litres capacity. These (garden centre-type) products tend to be for a different market outlet from bulk sales. In the first case, bagged products were only priced as ex-works and did not include any subsequent retail value. In the case of bulk compost, this tends to be delivered by truck in up to 60 cubic metre loads, although smaller quantities, typically 10 or 20 cubic metres are also available.

2. Compost Types ---

Of the responding companies, a range of composted materials were available. These were based on the following, usually as a single main ingredient:

- Greenwaste
- “Peat-free composted” (i.e. not specified)
- Composted bark
- Biosolids
- Spent mushroom substrates (SMS)
- Composted woodchip
- Green waste plus peat
- Wood fibre

Most suppliers will provide only one or two materials from the range above.

3. Results ---





Figure 2: Price per litre of bagged compost available in Scotland ex-works (Aug 01)

Bagged compost was available as a total of 38 different products. The range of bag sizes is shown in Figure 1. While some material is available in bags with less than 10 litre capacity, the majority are in excess of 40 litre. The most common size is 80 litre capacity and this supports earlier survey work carried out by SAC into the peat market in previous yearsⁱ. The second most popular size is a 40 litre bag, which typically represents an easy carry-home size. Little compost is produced in bags larger than 80 litres, with no responding supplier producing material in mini-bales, as is common for the peat market. This may be due to the generally higher bulk density of compost compared to peat. The price of compost is presented as pence per litre for each of the bag sizes (Figure 2). Not unexpectedly, the highest price per litre relates to those products in small bag volumes (in the 10-20 litre range). The range of quoted prices was considerable, varying from 26 pence per litre for bags up to 10 litre capacity, to 1.15 pence per litre for large bulk bags (up to 125 litre capacity). The overall average price per litre of bagged composted material was 9.27 pence per litre.

Figure 1: Number of composted products per bag size available in Scotland

Bulk compost was offered by eight companies at an average of £15.39 per cubic metre. The range of prices was from £2.20 - £41.50 per cubic metre. However, there was considerable reticence in this area of business, as the majority of companies clearly stated a preference for quoting a specific price for an individual tender. Four companies refused to provide any quote. From the various discussions, it was apparent that significant savings can be made for bulk or regular purchases, and therefore this particular information should be considered as a guide only.

Availability of compost is severely limited by the restrictions on sale of compost from licence-exempt sites. A number of significant compost manufacturers are known to be creating quality compost, but this material is unavailable in the market place, because it is a condition of the exemption that the material may not be sold. Such sites have been excluded from the survey data reported here.

4. Comparison to Peat

There are few primary producers of peat-based products in Scotland. This is despite the fact that Scotland has significant peat resources. However, these are often of a non-horticultural grade and are not suitable for the manufacture of products equivalent to composted materials or for landscape purposes. The price range for peat quoted from Scottish suppliers was in the range 2.38 pence – 3.6 pence per litre. Consequently, it would appear that Scottish compost producers are already working at a potential cost advantage and market position, compared to the existing bulk peat market.

None of the Scottish compost manufacturers were offering a processed high-quality growing medium which could be considered comparable to peat-based products having adjusted fertiliser value and specific physical properties.
